

Bookmark, Corner Fox

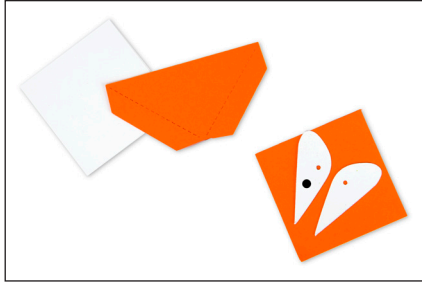

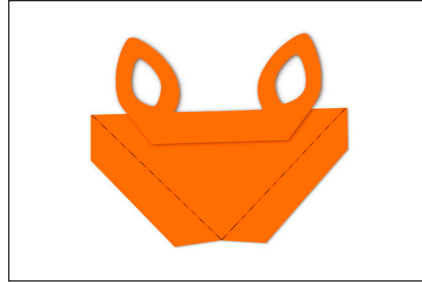

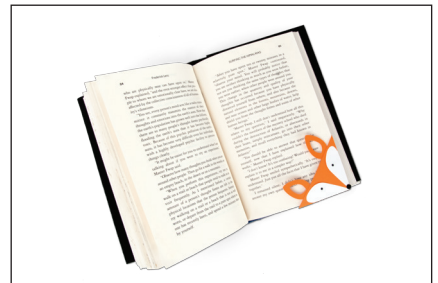

The teacher will die-cut the materials for student use prior to the lesson.

1. Die-cut the bookmark from colored paper or cardstock (Figure A).
2. Attach the ear piece to the triangular base (Figure B).
3. Turn the base over, and add the other details to the fox (Figure C). If you want the eyes to be black, attach a scrap of black paper behind each eye hole.
4. Fold the tabs on the perforations of the triangular base, add adhesive to the tabs and attach the triangular section to the white square base (Figure D).
5. The bookmark slides onto the corner of the book page to mark the student's place (Figures E & F).
